Week 1	<p>Week 1: Investigate 3 - 4 saints using the websites on the link provided https://www.avemariapress.com/engagingfaith/catholic-saints-research-projects Create a character profile on each Saint including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Image of Saint - Patron of ? - Feast Day - Canonization Date - Background info - Family Life - How, when and why this person became a Saint?
Week 2 - 4	<p>Choose one Saint for your Confirmation name. Take detailed notes about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Key events of your Saint's life - Qualities, dispositions and values of your Saint - How their actions affected those around them - Any leadership qualities that your Saint has that you would like in your life - Is this saint someone you can relate to? What similarities are there between this saint's life and your own? What differences are there? - Why have you chosen this Saint as your Confirmation name? - Is there something in the story of this saint that you could apply in your life, or something you can learn from this saint? If so, what is it?
